Awards Granted and Point Requirements:

- A. Grade Level Certificate of Recognition upon earning eight honor points. All honor points must be earned in the school year for which the award is granted.
- B. Grade Level Pins upon earning eleven honor points. All honor points must be earned in the school year for which the award is granted.
 - 1. 6th grade pins shall be bronze in color.
 - 2. 7th grade pins shall be silver in color.
 - 3. 8th grade pins shall be gold in color.
- C. Students who transfer from schools outside of West Middle School after the beginning of the school year may be eligible for awards as follows:
