2:45-3:15 - School Halloween Movie Party in Gym  
3:15-3:45 - School Parade (LOOP closed for pedestrian traffic)  
3:45-4:00 - Dismissal (LOOP will reopen after parade for dismissal)



### Halloween Snacks:

K-5<sup>th</sup> Grade Halloween Snacks may be enjoyed in the classrooms before 2:30 p.m. in classrooms. Your child's teacher will contact you with the appropriate times for parents to help with snacks and/or costumes.

### Holiday/Classroom Celebrations and Parties with Food:

RCS has published its Guidelines and Protocols for Students with Food Allergies. All District elementary classroom parties should **NOT** include homemade products. All foods must include the manufacturers' labels and should avoid known allergens that could potentially cause life-threatening anaphylactic reactions. This will help keep all students safe. ### Halloween Parade:

Classes will enjoy an outdoor Halloween Parade from 3:15-3:45 p.m. We will begin with the Kindergarten classes followed by the 5<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> graders.

Our route will begin with a lap around the gym, then through the Main Lobby, out towards the Loop, and around the Loop itself. After the parade, students will reenter the building through the lobby doors.

We encourage parents to enjoy the Halloween Parade from the vantage point of the far side of the Loop that borders the parking lot to make way for the children's parade.

### Dismissal:

A sign out sheet will be in each classroom for parents who wish to sign their children out early.

### Costumes:

For the safety and well-being of your children we have established these rules Halloween costumes.

- Costumes are to be brought in a labeled bag or backpack. They are not to be worn to school.
- No fake blood, toy weapons, or other symbols of violence are allowed.
- Colored hairspray must be applied at home before coming to school. (It is difficult to clean colored hairspray off school bathroom and classroom floors and walls. Also, students with breathing challenges may be affected by the spray.)
- Make sure costumes are not too long or bulky so that children can walk up and down stairs without falling or tripping.
- Masks or hoods need large eye and nose holes.
- Please help your child follow these rules. Have a safe and happy Halloween
