## NONRESIDENT TUITION STUDENTS

Students, whose parents do not reside within the Rochester Community Schools, but who present evidence that they will move into the school district within six (6) months, and not to exceed one school year, may enroll in school as tuition students for the time not in residence. The following guidelines must be adhered to:

1. A copy of residency intention must be presented to the Supervisor of Student Enrollment. The following documents are acceptable:
  - a. Building contract
  - b. Purchase agreement
  - c. Rental agreement
  - d. Building permit
2. Prior to enrolling in the Rochester Community Schools, a tuition payment must be made to the Rochester Community Schools for the yearly-established tuition rate. In addition, the parent(s) must obtain a membership release in accordance with the State Aid Act.
