

ASSEMBLIES

WHO MAY ATTEND?

All ACE students may attend certain assemblies at their home school. The district on a basis of residency determines home schools.

WILL IT COUNT AS AN ABSENCE?

If proper procedures are followed, the absence will be exempt, only if all procedures are followed. Otherwise, the absence will be unexcused.

WHAT TIME MAY I LEAVE?

The time for assemblies may vary. Usually they are held at the end of the day. It is the responsibility of the student to check with the Secretary for the time students may leave ACE.

MAY A PARENT CALL IN TO EXCUSE?

Yes, a parent must call into the Secretary before the student is allowed to leave school grounds. This call must be made before a student leaves ACE. Students may not use the office telephone or ACE telephones to contact parents the day of the event. Permission must be called in the day before the event. Arrangements must be made on student time, not class time.

CAN STUDENTS RIDE WITH OTHER STUDENTS TO THE ASSEMBLY?

Students may ride with other students if the parents of the rider give permission to the Secretary when they call her.

DO I HAVE TO REPORT IN AT THE ASSEMBLY?

Yes, students must report in to the Attendance Office both before and after the assembly. If the student did not report to the Attendance Office, their attendance cannot be exempt and the absence will be unjustified.

DO I NEED MY ACE STUDENT I.D.?

Yes, your I.D. is required at all times when at school. It will be needed to identify you at the Attendance Office.
