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Dear Parents / Guardians:

The safety and welfare of students is of the utmost priority in Rochester Community Schools. During the school day, students and staff work cooperatively to create an environment that is conducive to student learning. After school, students have the opportunity to participate in a variety of supervised activities, including athletics, clubs, intramurals and meetings with staff members. Reuther Middle School encourages students to take advantage of these opportunities to enhance their educational experience.

In order to maintain a safe school environment, students who are not involved in supervised after-school activities are expected to leave the Reuther Middle School campus by 2:40 p.m. Students who are walkers are expected leave the school campus at the end of the school day. If a student needs to return to schedule to pick up items left at school, they should do so prior to 3:30 p.m. and must check in at the main office. It is the responsibility of parents or guardians to make arrangements that ensure their student has an appropriate place to go after school.

Students who remain on campus in an unsupervised capacity will be subject to Section E-5 in the Student Code of Conduct, which addresses trespassing and loitering.
