

# ACE High School

## Description of a Successful Student

Students at ACE High School will become academically successful, have exceptional attendance, and exhibit proper student behaviors. These three areas will be measured and reported each week, by all teachers, and the students will be notified on Mondays by their mentors using the Successful Student Rubric ( SSR) to communicate . Parents will be notified by their student on Monday evening. Parents will sign the SSR and students will return the SSR to their mentor on Tuesday morning in Study Skills class.

### *Student Grades*

- Students can earn 10 points per week for having all C's or better in all classes
- Students do not receive any points for having a D or an E in any class

### *Student Attendance*

- Students will attend every period, every day as set forth in the school calendar
- Students earn one attendance point per period for being in class on time
- Students cannot earn an attendance point if they are absent or tardy (without an excused note) to a class
- Students **cannot** make-up missed attendance points for any reason

### *Student Behavior*

- Students will report to class with the required materials and supplies to complete the daily lessons
- Students will put forth their best effort to complete all of the required assignments each period and finish whatever homework they might have for the next day
  - If needed, the next day's study skill's class will be used to access additional assistance to complete the assignments and obtain the knowledge required
  - Students will remain on task, be cooperative to the staff and fellow classmates, and seek out assistance when needed
- Students will ask for missing work upon returning from an absence, at the start or end of class. If it is Friday, the student should email his/her teachers to request work
- Students can earn one behavior point per period for demonstrating the required behaviors of a successful student.
- Students can still earn their behavior point if they ask for and obtain their missing work, due to an absence, at the proper time
- Students can lose one behavior point per period for not demonstrating the required behaviors of a successful student
- Teachers will notify each student's mentor as to the number of behavior points earned each week
- Students can lose additional behavior points due to infractions and incidents outside the classroom
- Higher level behavioral issues will be covered under the Rochester Community School's Code of Conduct
