# *Practicum*

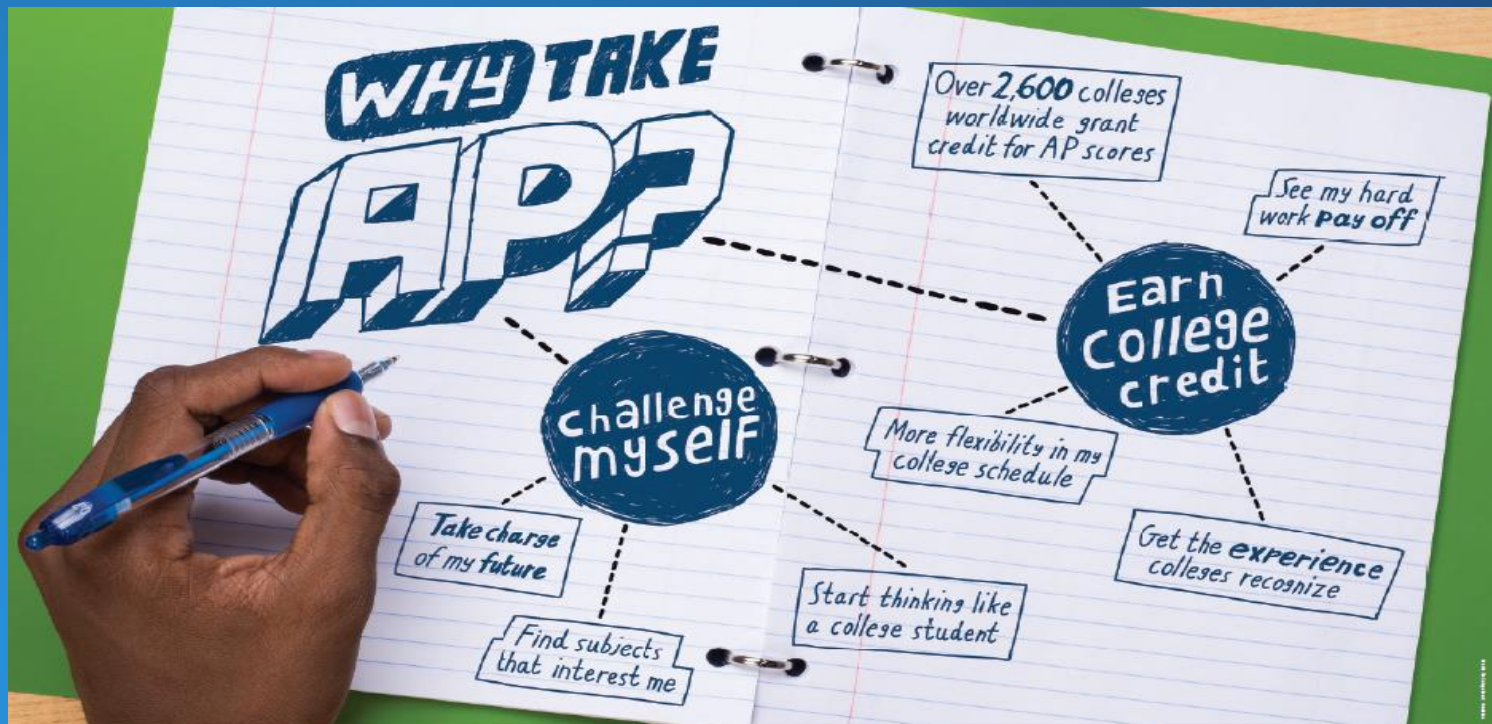
- Business Department semester elective

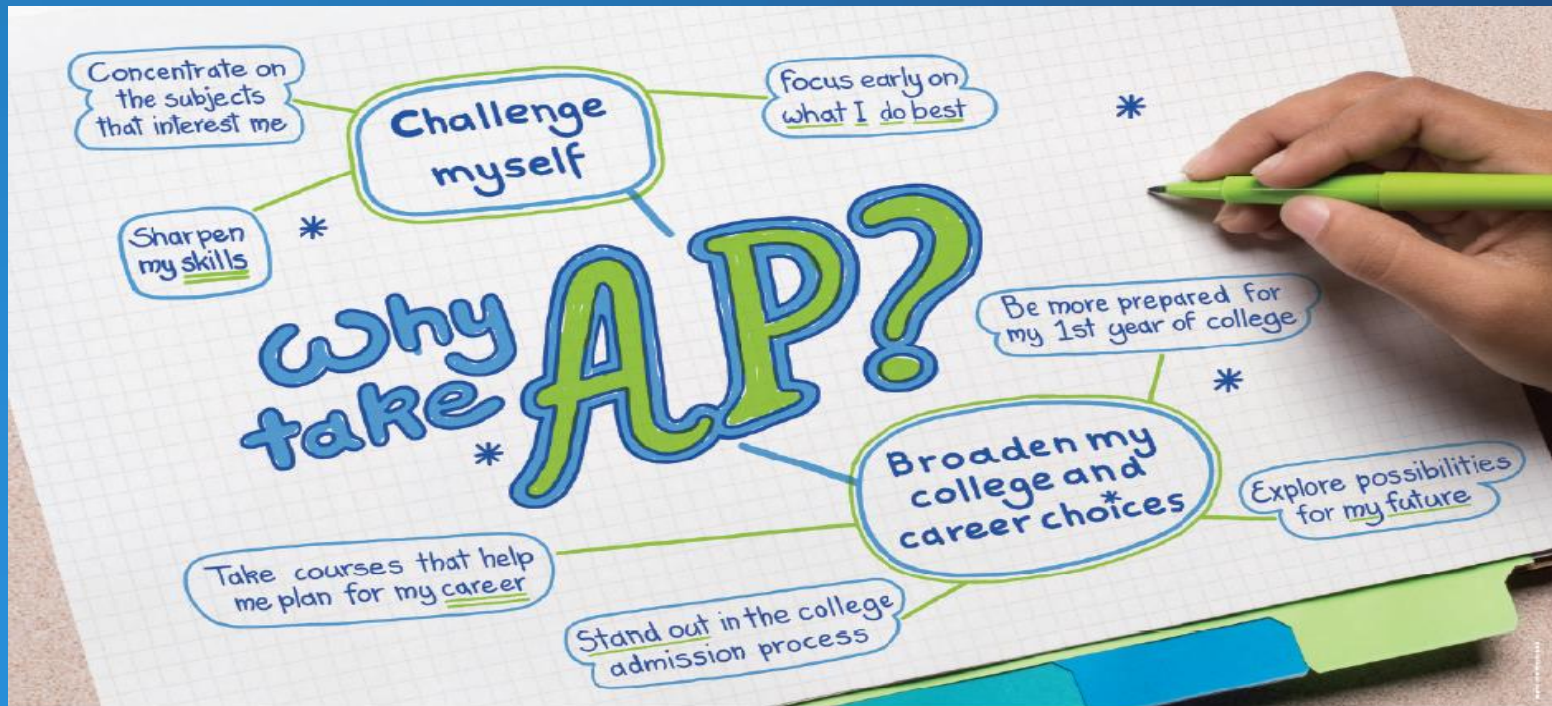
- Online courses available
- Self-motivated students



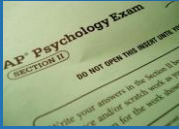

- Significant time commitment

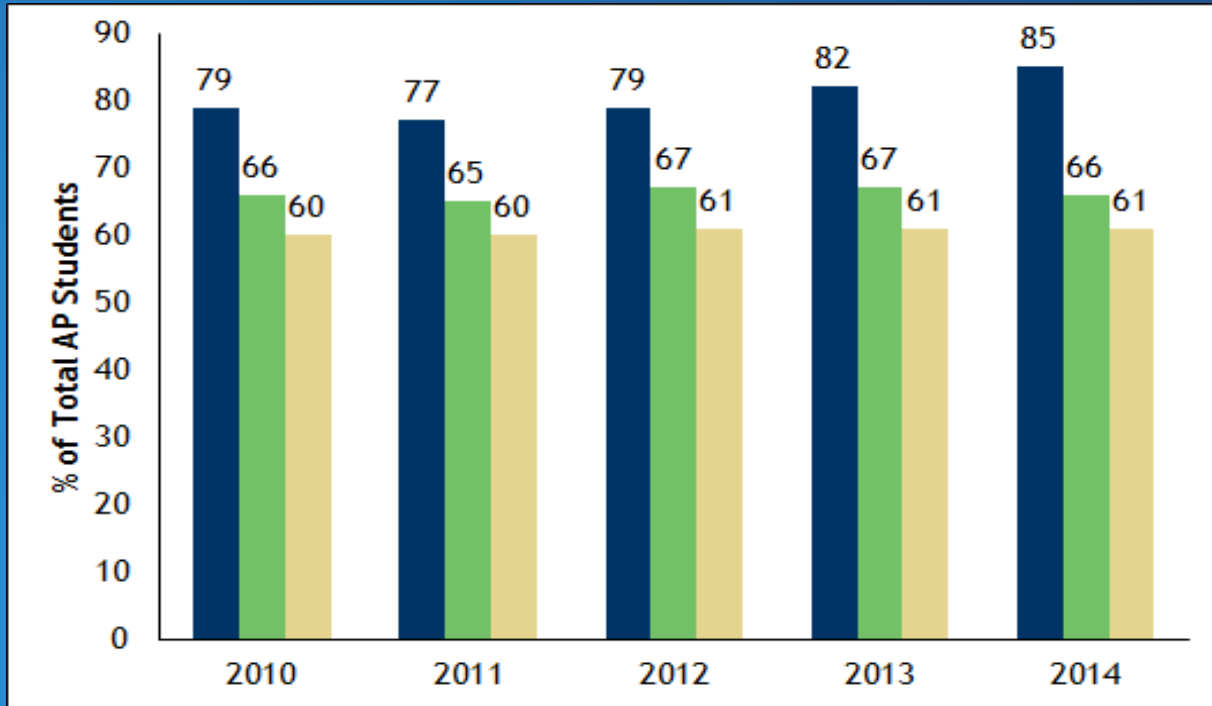


# *How Many AP's?*
