

Authors in April (1 time, 2-3 hours)

This committee assists on the day of our Author visit, which occurs in April.

Box Tops/Campbell Soup Labels (.5- 4 hours at 1-4 sessions)

Assist with cutting/stacking and boxing up box tops and Campbell soup labels several times throughout the school year. There is a competition between homerooms for collecting the most and the committee assists with the celebration party!

Community Service (dependent on number of events)

Coordinate community service events to aide our families and work with Rochester Area Neighborhood House (RANH) to aide our community. Assist with delivering meals to seniors in need through OPC on three dates throughout the year.

Cultural Heritage Week (dependent on number of events)

Expand the cultural knowledge of our students. Modeled from the programs presented in the elementary schools, this will be our first year presenting such a richly diverse experience for our students!

Dance (2 hours at 1 or more of 4 dances)

Assist with Pizza/Drink sales, or other concessions at the dances held after school.

District Dialogue Representative (2-3 hours per meeting)

Attend the District Dialogue meetings put on by Rochester Schools Administration. Bring an update to the PTSA meeting, or give to the board.

Directory (1-2 hours)

Assist with the sales of student directories at lunch period and during school events.

Eighth grade Farewell (1-2 hours once a month)

Organize, plan and create the activities for the farewell celebration for our 8th graders, held in June.

Health & Welfare Committee (dependent on issues)

Meet as needed to discuss any issues that arise regarding the health and welfare of our students.

Honor Roll Recognition (2 hours 3 times per year)

Organize a recognition celebration after each of the first three marking period to honor the students who have achieved the Honor Roll status.

Ice Cream Social (1 time, 1-2 hours)

Help with setup/serving/clean up of our annual Ice Cream Social in late April or May.

Legislative Representative (1-2 hours once a month)

Keep the PTSA informed on any important legislative information regarding our schools/students by attending the district legislative a few times in the year.

Media Center Volunteers (1-2 hour shifts available each week)

Assist the media specialist in our media center throughout the school year.

Membership (4-8 hours at registration and ongoing monthly e-mail contact)

These are important volunteers who oversee membership drives in the beginning and mid school year and maintain our membership information.

Parisian Discount Days (from home or 2 hours at one of several Parisian Days)

Selling discount tickets and assisting at the Parisian sale fundraiser.

Publicity- The representative would be in charge of putting information about all the great successes Reuther students, staff or PTSA has done into the local paper and updating the PTSA bulletin board.

Office/Teacher Copy Helper (1-2 hour shifts available each week)

This committee will assist in the office 1 time a week for whatever the office or teacher's might need help with, mostly copying, laminating and updating the communication sign in the front of the school.

Reflections (2-3 meetings and reception)

This committee assists with the PTSA Reflections contest held at Reuther in the beginning of the school year and the award ceremony. Given a theme to work from, kids can express their talents through art, writing, or music.

Registration (2-3 hours during August registration days)

Assistance is needed with our biggest membership drive of the year as well as with locker organizer or supply sales or other tables.

School store (up to 2 hours once or twice a month- flexible)

This committee will assist with running the school store during the lunch periods a couple times a week, offer concessions during dances and possibly during home athletics.

Staff Appreciation (send items from home or 1-2 hours during events)

Send in treats to match the theme of the celebration, or assist in preparing a luncheon for our wonderful staff members a few times throughout the school year.
