The myRCS web site is a collection of student data for parents, students, and staff of Rochester Community Schools. The student data that is available includes attendance, report cards, elementary teacher assignments, schedules, bus information and more!

Within 24 hours of enrolling your child in the district, you will receive an email containing your myRCS username and temporary password. Just follow the instructions and links within the email message to get started.

The teacher placement, scheduling, and bus information will be available in late August for the following school year. Keep an eye out in your email for a message containing specific dates and more information as the new school year approaches.

FAQ

Q: It's been over 24 hours and I haven't received an email containing my login information. What now?

A: Check your spam/junk email folder for the message. If your child is enrolled for the next school year, you will not receive an email until mid-July.

Q: I've checked my spam/junk folder and still nothing. What do I do now?

A: Send an email to myrcshelp@rochester.k12.mi.us with a brief description of your issue. Include your child's name, building, and your own name.

Q: I have my username, but forgot my password. How do I reset my password?

A: If you have your username(parent id) you can reset your own password. Just access the myRCS login page from a non-mobile device and click on the 'Reset Password' link. Follow the on-screen instructions.

Q: I forgot my username. How do I obtain it?

A: Send an email to myrcshelp@rochester.k12.mi.us with a brief description of your issue. Include your child's name, building, and your own name.
