Van Hoosen Middle School Electronic Devices Policy

The School District reserves the right to prohibit the possession or use of personal electronic devices on School District property or at School District-related functions. For purposes of this Policy, “personal electronic device” means a privately owned device that is used for audio, video or text communications.

Students are permitted to use personal electronic devices only as follows:

- Before and after the regular school day.
- As directed or permitted by a teacher or other professional staff member for educational purposes.

Electronic devices should be turned off and stored in students’ lockers before the start of homeroom through the end of the school day.

VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN CONSEQUENCES FROM THE STEP SYSTEM.

(If a student is found in violation of the policy listed above, the device will be sent to the main office and a parent will be contacted to come and pick up the device. A repeat violation will result in placement on the Step System.)
