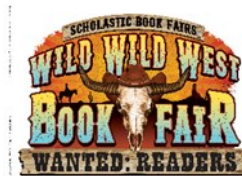

- Select “continue” if the school information is correct.
- Select “buy a yearbook, yearbook packages & other cool stuff”.
- Enter the quantity you wish to purchase and then select “buy these items”.
- A dialogue box will appear “buy this yearbook for:” Select “student”.
- Enter name and search. Select correct name from list.
- If the search does not find the student’s name, use the option “add new student name” at the bottom of the page.
