### Illness / Exclusion Policy

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| Ill Children | Regardless of the precautions taken at home or school, your child may become ill during the course of the school year. If your child becomes ill you will be called and asked to pick up your child within the hour. If you are unavailable, we will call someone on your Emergency Card. If your child has been absent due to a contagious disease (such as strep throat or pink eye) you will be required to present a physician's certificate in order for the child to return to school. Please be aware that we do not reimburse or credit your account for absences due to illness, nor are you able to make up this day on another day.              |
| Exclusion    | Your child will be excluded from attending if he or she has any of the following symptoms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fever (temperature of 100° or more)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Child must be free of fever for 24 hours (without fever reducing medication) in order to return.</li></ul></li><li>• Diarrhea or vomiting<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Child must be symptom free for 24 hours in order to return.</li></ul></li><li>• Discharge from the eye or ear</li><li>• Green or yellow discharge from the nose</li><li>• Persistent or productive cough</li><li>• Sore throat</li><li>• Skin rash</li></ul> |
