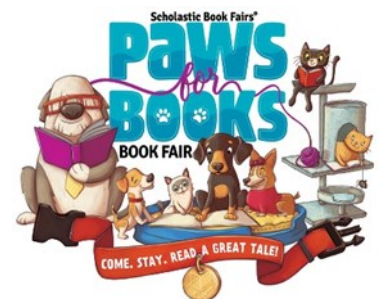

On Thursday March 22, 2018, Hart will host two OK2SAY assemblies. One for 7<sup>th</sup> graders and one for 8<sup>th</sup> graders.

The program is spearheaded by Michigan Attorney General's office and the focus of the presentation is student safety featuring the Michigan Cyber Safety (CSI) and student safety hotline, OK2SAY.
