# GET SET FOR SUMMER READING

Use the RCS Digital Library to access free e-books and audiobooks

You have access to hundreds of free e-books & audiobooks in the Rochester Community Schools Digital Library. You can read these books online or on your devices.

All you need to borrow digital titles is an internet connection and your Rochester username and password.

Books can be checked out for a 14-day or 21-day period.

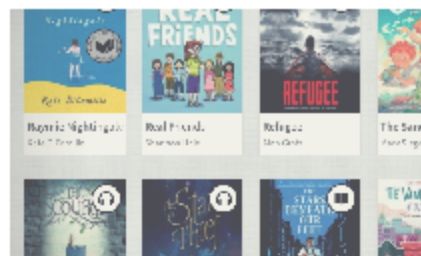
You can search by new releases, recent additions, and popular reads. Check out the collection to find a great book!

If you're using a tablet or smartphone, you may want to download OverDrive's free app, OverDrive Media Console, to easily find and download titles to your device.

Use the app's **add a library** feature to find and save the Rochester Community Schools Digital Library.

Click the **sign in** link in the upper-right corner to sign into your **account** using your school login credentials.

Once you find an available title to borrow, click **borrow**.



You can also read/listen to titles right in your internet browser. Simply click **read in browser** next to the borrowed book to begin reading.
