Curriculum Connections

Every Hampton student in grades K-5 receive one hour of media instruction per week

The Kindergartners have been continuing to work on logging into the computer with their unique usernames and passwords as well as signing out. They used the graphics program Kid Pix 3d and learned to navigate educational websites.

The First graders worked hard at saving documents to their "H drive" and even created a slideshow presentation using Kid Pix 3d software. They worked on note taking and research skills as well!

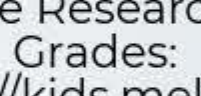
The second graders began gaining experience with their Google Apps for Education account by using Google Classroom. They also collaborated with their classmates to create a Google Slides presentation and worked on using educational databases for research.

All students in Third through Fifth grade create websites using Google Sites. These sites highlight their learning at Hampton throughout the school year. They learned about digital citizenship and internet safety through lessons with Common Sense Media, Interland, and Digital Passport. They also practiced typing skills with programs such as NitroType, Typing Club, and Type to Learn. The students all worked with Google Apps such as Slides, Docs, and Google Classroom. Students also demonstrated teamwork by solving clues to open locks on their Breakout Kits and worked with coding and programming by participating in Hour of Code and using Ozobots.

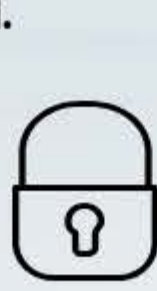

Breakout Kits!

Breakouts use a compelling story, time limit, and series of puzzles to create an interactive game for students. They must work together to break into a tightly locked box with different locks before the timer runs out. Puzzles lead to the combinations for the different types of locks, and many games also include a digital element.

Each game requires students to use collaboration, communication, critical thinking and creativity in order to succeed.



MakerSpace

Hampton's Makerspace provides students opportunities to explore, build, experiment, and create using Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math. The students worked with various materials (robots, circuit boards, toy building, legos, etc) in groups or independently solving challenges. We anticipate many more Maker opportunities in the new media center space next year!
