Band 6/7/8: 1 inch black binder

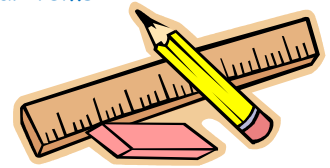
Foods/Life skills 7 and 8: Folder
