BASES GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

After school is your time, it belongs to you! Enroll in a class with a friend! Registration is easy via online registration, phone or in person. Please do not send registrations to your child's school. If you would like your child to attend a BASES class at a different schools, parents are responsible for providing transportation between schools. **Registration closes at 3:00pm, two business days prior to the start of the first class, so register now!**

REGISTER BY PHONE OR ONLINE

We accept all major credit cards. Please call 248-726-3165 Monday - Friday (8:30am - 4:30pm). To register online, go to the RCS web page (www.rochester.k12.mi.us) and hover over the Departments tab to bring down the drop-down menu, then select Enrichment. When the Enrichment page loads, click on the blue Register Now button and follow the instructions on how to set up a household profile if you do not have one already. After you've set up your household, or logged in to your account you can begin registering for the class. If you prefer to pay with cash, you can do so at the Enrichment Office, located on the third floor of the Administration Center. Cash payments must be the exact amount of the class.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid may be available. Call Rochester Area Youth Assistance at 248-656-3558 as soon as possible, as the process takes some time.

REFUND POLICY

-Cancellations made more than 7 days prior to the start of class will receive a full refund, minus a \$10 processing fee.

-Cancellations made less than 7 days prior to the start of class will receive a full refund, minus a \$25 processing fee.

-Cancellations made after the start of the second class will not receive a refund.

-Cancellations made due to an emergency will receive a pro-rated refund minus a \$10 processing fee, if approved by the Enrichment Department.

-School rules and the Student Code of Conduct apply for BASES classes. If a student's behavior is inappropriate, their parent or guardian will be notified to pick them up immediately. If a second incident occurs, the student will be removed from all remaining sessions and no refund will be given.

CLASS MAKEUP

Class make-up dates are built into our class schedules. In the event that a make-up date is utilized, no refunds or transfers will be given if a child cannot attend the make-up date.

NUT FREE POLICY

Do not bring any food items that contain nuts of any kind to our school classes.

LATE PICKUP

Children cannot walk home from BASES class. You must be on time to pick up children. BASES cannot guarantee supervision after class. If parents are late picking up their child, they will be charged \$20 for the first 15 minutes, and 10 for each 15 minutes thereafter. An invoice will be emailed and full payment must be paid prior to attending the next schedule session.
