What a wonderful and very busy first week! This school newsletter, The University Hills Messenger, will be sent home every Friday. It is full of very important information. Please take some time each weekend to review our newsletter. We hope you find it helpful.

University Hills takes great pride in our community working in partnership to keep our students safe at all times. It is of the utmost importance for all of us to work together to ensure that every child and adult is safe during morning arrival and afternoon dismissal. The following protocol has been put into place for all to follow.

- When dropping off your student in the car line, you need to follow the directions of Anne Greig, UH para professional. Anne is skilled and experienced. She will let you know when it is safe for you to proceed.
- After you pull into the loop, your child will exit on the median side only for safety. Please do not get out
 of your car!
- A volunteer or fifth grade service member will assist students (backpack, lunch tote, bags) that are having difficulty exiting the car.
- If this process will not work for you, we ask that you park in the lot and assist your child with coming to the crosswalk.
- We ask that you, the parent, remain in the car the entire time you are in the drop off circle. If you must help your child, we request that you please proceed to a parking space.

It is of extreme importance that every member of our community follows the above protocol. Student safety is at the forefront.
