

SCHEDULING INFO (current 9th grade scheduling for 10th)

FRONT OF CARD

A. REQUIRED COURSES (Please make sure you schedule both semesters of year-long courses when entering course requests online).

- ⇒ **English:** Students are required to take a full year of Language Arts 10. Current LA9 students who wish to be considered for Honors LA10 must speak with their LA9 teacher.
- ⇒ **Social Studies:** Students are required to take a full year of US History. Advanced Placement (AP) US History is intended only for the highly motivated student who has a strong interest in history and is academically prepared to handle the rigor of this advanced course. The AP course is also a full-year commitment; once the student schedules for this course, he/she will remain in the course. Students interested in taking AP US History must complete the AP US History Survey form.
- ⇒ **Science:** Students are required to take a full year of Biology. Students who do not pass both semesters of Physical Science will need to complete it in summer school, or repeat it next year. *For students who are currently taking the Physical Science/Biology combination course – please consult with your science teacher about the next science class you will be taking (i.e. Chem/FundChem or Physics/FundPhys or other elective). **Students who sign up for Chemistry or Physics courses should also be aware of the math recommendation for these classes.**
- ⇒ **Math:** Students must see their FIRST SEMESTER math teacher for placement recommendation and signature.

B. ELECTIVES:

- ⇒ 10th grade elective choices can be found on the Course Offerings sheet. Students may select any combination of one or two semester courses. Please remember to schedule for both semesters of any year-long courses entered.
- ⇒ For Marching Band and/or Jazz Band, check the box at the bottom of section B (Electives)

Other things to keep in mind.....

- The course offerings sheet has info on course numbers and number of semesters.
- World Language electives above Level 1 require a teacher signature.
- All classes that are asterisked (*) on course sheet require a teacher signature.

- It is recommended that Wellness 1 or PE Elective be completed by the end of the 10th grade year.
- Check class prerequisites carefully (*i.e. you must take 2D art before Draw/Paint*)
