

# SCHEDULING INFO (current 11<sup>th</sup> grade scheduling for 12<sup>th</sup>)

## **FRONT OF CARD**

- A. ENGLISH:** Students are required to take a 12<sup>th</sup> grade Comp/Lit or Comp/Lang Combo. English combinations are listed on the Course Offerings sheet – please choose the appropriate combination number. *If you are currently taking AP Language, please strongly consider scheduling for AP Literature.*
- B. MATH:** Students are required to take Math or Math-Related courses during the senior year.
- C. ELECTIVES:** 12<sup>th</sup> grade elective choices can be found on Course Offerings sheet. Students may select any combination of one or two semester courses.
- D. STUDENT AND PARENT SIGNATURES:** Sign card, review selections with parents and have a parent sign card. Cards that are not complete or that do not have required signatures will not be accepted.

## **BACK OF CARD**

**ALTERNATES:** When choosing alternates, please keep in mind that you may be scheduled into them if your first choice classes are not available. Alternates must be listed in order of preference.

- E. ENGLISH ALTERNATES:** Choose two English alternate classes that are different from what you entered on the front. Please number them in order of preference (#1 and #2). You do not need to enter alternates if you are taking AP English.
- F. ALTERNATE ELECTIVE COURSES:** Choose Alternate choices for all other elective classes. All 5 lines must be filled out. ***Cards without alternates will not be accepted!***
- G. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Please supply the information requested.

## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

- If you are planning on applying to a college/university in the fall of your senior year, your senior year schedule should include at least 8 to 10 academic classes.
- **AP courses are intended for the highly motivated student, have the rigor of college level courses, require intense reading, and are full-year commitments.**
- World Language (beyond level 2) and traditional math courses require a teacher signature.
- **If you sign up for a full year course you will be expected to remain in that course for the full-year.**
- All classes that have an asterisk (\*) on the course offerings sheet require a teacher signature.
- All courses that have a plus sign (+) have a prerequisite.
  - Check class prerequisites carefully (*ex. You must have completed 2D Art before Draw/Paint, etc.*)
- OTECH applications were due in December. If you still would like to be considered for OTECH and have not yet filled out an application, please see your counselor for one.
- For Marching Band and Jazz Band, check the selection box at the bottom of the ELECTIVES box.

**If your transcript indicates that you have earned fewer than 13 credits, you will need to earn additional credits through summer school/credit recovery and should consult with your counselor. You need to begin your senior year with a minimum of 16 credits!**
