RECOGNITION, FOOD, AND ENTERTAINMENT

Rochester Community Schools greatly values students, staff, parents, and community members. The District encourages recognition of students, staff, and volunteer achievements. The District believes that recognition of achievements, food, and entertainment contribute to a pleasant work place for staff and provides an encouraging school learning environment for students.

Rochester Community Schools is a public institution funded with taxpayer dollars. The District's public funds are for the purpose of free and appropriate public education for students and cannot be used for private purposes, private gain, or gifts.

The District encourages mutually beneficial collaboration with individuals and other organizations to provide private funds or grants for the purposes of recognition, food, and entertainment. The use of any private funds or grant funds for these purposes must follow the provider agreement/contract.

Staff or volunteer recognition and all entertainment expenditures can only be provided through private funding or grant funding.

Regulations will provide guidelines concerning the use of public funds for recognition, food, and entertainment.
