Transporting students in the Rochester Community School District is an involved and complicated task. It requires the cooperation of everyone to make it successful. Parents should establish with their children, guidelines for the following:

- The route they should take between home and the bus stop.
- Proper attire for the weather.
- Conduct on the bus.
- Conduct at the bus stop.

Once again some routes will be combined with Hart Middle School students. It is critical that bus behavior be appropriate. Loud, boisterous, or profane language; indecent conduct, throwing of articles; or anything that could distract the driver or injure others will not be tolerated. Any of the above behaviors could result in a disciplinary action.

Students, who need to ride a bus other than the one they were assigned, must obtain an authorized permission form from the school office or Transportation. Notes to the bus driver or the school will not be accepted as authorized permission.
